

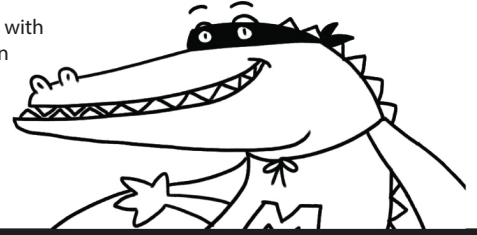
Snakes take you backwards from nose to tip of the tail.
